CLLC classes resume Wednesday, January 5, 2022

> School holiday (per GISD calendar) Monday, January 17

In case of bad weather (ice and snow), classes at the Learning Center will be canceled or delayed if deemed necessary for safety precautions. CLLC will monitor the weather during such days and send updates via REMIND.

Please send your child to school in clothing that is appropriate for the weather. Warm jackets and hats are very important as we will be going outdoors. Only if it is raining or bitterly cold at the outdoor time will we be playing in the gym. Also check to make sure that the change of clothing in your child's backpack is appropriate for the current weather. Some haven't had an accident (yea!) in quite awhile, and still have warm weather clothing.

Due to the Christmas holiday schedule, January 2022 tuition will not be considered late as long as it is paid by January 10th. If paid after the 10th, please include the \$25.00 late fee. Tuition envelopes will be in your child's cubby when you return to school. Thank you!

We ask that you mark your child's jacket, cap, and gloves with their name. Encourage your child to be observant of what he/she is wearing and where he/she puts coats, hats, etc. These are good habits to form before your child gets into "big school."

ADDITIONAL REMINDERS

*** If your Christmas holiday plans included seeing loved ones that you have not seen in some time, we ask that you be very diligent in monitoring your child's health and the health of other family members before sending your child back to CLLC upon your return from the holidays.

Parents: With all the coughs and colds going around at this time of the year, we need to make sure our children are well before coming back to school. This is not only for the well-being of the other children, but for your child also. Please consult the **HEALTH POLICY STATEMENT** that is in the Parent Handbook (this can be found on preschool website www.cllcpreschool.com) if you have any questions or concerns about our policies. If your child has any of the symptoms listed, please keep your child at home until these symptoms disappear or until your physician determines that your child can return to school without spreading an infection to others.

*** Pickup is at 2:00.....please do not be late. Late charges begin at 2:10 p.m. at \$1 per minute. Same for 4:00 and 4:30 pick-up. Late charges apply after ten minutes.

*** Your child's bedding must be washed weekly according to licensing regulations.

*** If you must pick up your child early from school, please let your child's teacher know ahead of time so she can make the necessary arrangements to have your child ready to go when you arrive.
