TODDLER CLASS (18-23 months)

- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks (Elmer's brand only, please)
- 2 box Kleenex tissues
- 3 containers baby wipes
- 4 bottles hand soap (7.5 fl. oz. or larger)
- 1 large canister of LYSOL spray disinfectant
- 2 box plastic spoons
- 1 package 6" paper plates (uncoated)

TWO YEAR OLD CLASS

- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks (Elmer's brand only, please)
- 2 box Kleenex tissues
- 3 containers baby wipes
- 4 bottles hand soap (7.5 fl. oz. or larger)
- 1 large canister of LYSOL spray disinfectant
- 2 box plastic spoons
- 1 package 6" paper plates (uncoated)

THREE YEAR OLD CLASS

- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks (Elmer's brand only, please)
- 2 box Kleenex tissues
- 3 containers baby wipes
- 4 bottles hand soap (7.5 fl. oz. or larger)
- 1 large canister of LYSOL spray disinfectant
- 1 box plastic spoons
- 1 box plastic fork
- 1 package 6" paper plates (uncoated)

FOUR & KINDER-PREP CLASS

- 4 rolls of paper towels
- 2 Elmer's glue sticks (Elmer's brand only, please)
- 2 box Kleenex tissues
- 3 containers baby wipes
- 4 bottles hand soap (7.5 fl. oz. or larger)
- 1 large canister of LYSOL spray disinfectant
- 1 box of Crayola markers (8 count)
- 1 box of thin EXPO Markers (colored) 4 count
- 1 plastic school box

If your toddler is in diapers, please send one bag of diapers to leave at school that will be used by your child only. Please write your child's name on the bag of diapers or you can label each diaper separately. If your child needs special wipes or creams, we ask that you send a supply that can be left at school in your child's diaper tub. Please label all items.
