Fall 2026 Classes

Admission Information forms, along with all other required enrollment forms for 2026 - 2027 classes will be sent home soon to those children that are currently enrolled for the 2026-27 school year. If you do not receive these forms, please see April or Sylvia. This packet includes the immunization record / physical form that is required by licensing to be completed before admission. Licensing standards require that all children in a child care facility be seen by a physician at least once a year. Since your child will not be allowed to begin class at the Learning Center without completion of this form, please plan to visit your physician or clinic early in the summer. **All enrollment forms are due in the preschool office by July 15, 2026.**

Please remember that your child's tuition for **May 2027** is due on June 1, 2026 and is considered late if paid after June 5, 2026. All late tuition payments are subject to a \$25 late fee. This tuition is refundable only if withdrawal is done before July 15, 2026. After July 15, no tuition is refundable unless it is due to a job transfer. A letter on company letterhead regarding the transfer will be required.
